WORSHIP: The mission of the Worship Commission is to continue the enhancing of our worship of God the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit through active participation in both music and worship following the tradition of our rich Anglican heritage, being ever mindful of the needs and desires of this Parish.

PARISH LIFE: The mission of the Parish Life Commission is to encourage participation through fellowship of all parishioners, new and old, in parish events throughout the year.

CHRISTIAN EDUCATION: The mission of the Christian Education Commission is to provide an environment that promotes spiritual development in both the children and adults, following the example of our Savior Jesus Christ.

CONGREGATIONAL CARE: The mission of the Congregational Care Commission is to extend the boundaries of St. Peter's beyond the church grounds to minister to the spiritual needs of those parishioners who cannot attend regular worship services and to offer practical assistance to those members of our parish experiencing short-term needs.

OUTREACH: The mission of the Outreach Commission is to proclaim and demonstrate the love of God in Jesus Christ our Lord within our own community and abroad giving truly of ourselves through God's grace.

STEWARDSHIP: The mission of the Stewardship Commission is to instill, develop, and nurture a true sense of stewardship within each member of our church.

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS: The mission of the Buildings and Grounds Ministry is to prepare and maintain the building and grounds of St. Peter's Parish Church for worship and historic preservation.
